### MISSION TRIP DETAILS

The Mission Trip fee is \$800 per person.

This fee includes the following:

- 6 nights hotel stay at The Hotel Aurora in Antigua
- Transportation while we are in Guatemala; including airport pickup & drop off at scheduled times, as well as any activities we do as a mission team
- Two bilingual translators to help assist with communication & translation with those we are serving
- Breakfast each morning made by the cooks at The Hotel Aurora
- 2 Dinners- Welcome Dinner & Farewell Dinner

In addition to the mission fee, you are responsible for the following things:

- Paying for an booking your flight into Guatemala City (GUA)
- Four dinners: Some of these evenings team members choose to eat together as a team but each person will pay for their own meal
- Optional Free Day Activity: Hike a volcano- Pacaya or go to Lake Atitlan.) You will be responsible for paying any fees associated with the activity you choose in addition to your meals on this day.
- Donations and fundraising needed for outreach projects we will serve on our trip. FTLOM does try to plan for our mission team members to have lunch with the projects we serve so typically there are not any additional expenses for lunches on the days we are with outreach projects
- You must have a valid passport to travel to Guatemala
- Spending money for any shopping you want to do

You will have the opportunity to sight see and shop each evening in Antigua. You will find that there are many markets, dining spots, ATM machines and sightseeing spots within walking distance of our hotel.
